## FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER'S OFFICE

Aloha mai e from Bali Hai Villas! Although Bali Hai Villas remained closed through the first quarter following Kauai Mayor Kawakami's request to temporarily pause Kauai's participation in the state's Safe Travels pre-travel testing program late last year, a skeleton crew was maintained to ensure the resort was kept safe and secure at all times. The team prepared for the resort to reopen in the near future by conducting Housekeeping, Maintenance, and special project work as time and resources permitted.

Bali Hai Villas reopened early-April as the Governor of Hawaii approved Kauai Mayor Kawakami's request to accept Kauai's active participation in the state's Safe Travels pre-travel testing program. The program mandates all incoming travel to Kauai be allowed with 72 hour advance testing procedures and stringent guidelines in place. As a result, a pre-opening team of formerly furloughed resort associates was invited back to full-time active duty across all operating departments. The team prepared the resort to once again provide memorable vacation experiences to owners and guests, albeit with many new (and possibly temporary) operating

procedures in place in order to ensure the safety of all.

With Bali Hai Villas reopened, owners, guests, associates and vendors are required to wear face masks in all indoor and outdoor public spaces as recommended by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and required by the State of Hawaii and Kauai County. Additionally, most amenities at the resort are reopened, including the Mahina and Wailele pools and the Clubhouse Fitness Center, albeit with restricted hours of operation, enhanced cleaning protocols, and social distancing practices in place.

Despite the resort's closure for the first quarter of 2021, improvements continued to be initiated for the benefit of all owners and guests. The shingled roof, gutters and downspouts of Building 8 were replaced, as were all exterior upper and lower landings at Building 13 with TREX composite decking. The moisture-compromised, wood-rotted exterior support columns of Building 6 were replaced with concrete/stucco and permanent waterproof roofing was installed atop the resort's exterior rubbish/recycling areas.







On behalf of our Board of Directors and our Bali Hai Villas 'ohana, we are excited to have reopened and are optimistic that travel to Kauai will begin again, that vacations will be enjoyed again as vaccinations continue to be distributed, and that memories lasting lifetimes will be made again. We look forward to safely and warmly welcoming you and your 'ohana back to Bali Hai Villas in the near future!
